2019 Membership Renewal Information – PLEASE READ!

Membership renewal will be an online process again this year, and we will continue using the Amilia registration software. Within the next few days, we will send an email notification advising that registration is open. This email will include instructions for accessing your Amilia account. From your account, you will easily be able to pay your dues and register kids for teams.

We will be scheduling office hours at the pool should you wish to have personal assistance with membership renewal. The dates and times of these office hours will be provided in the forthcoming renewal instruction email.

All Members who complete their renewal and pay in full by April 30, 2019 will receive 20 free guest passes – a \$100 value!

2019 Dues and Fees

The board is committed to keeping the cost of your membership reasonable and consistent with other similar swim clubs, and we are working hard to identify additional revenue sources. We are pleased to announce that Annual Membership Dues for 2019 are the same as 2018. However, due to the increased use of credit card payments by our members, we must pass along a portion of the cost of credit card processing. Details on this will be included in the forthcoming renewal instruction email. You will have the opportunity to avoid credit card processing fees by paying with a check.

The Capital Improvement Fee for 2019 will also remain at \$250 for the third consecutive year. This fee is paid by all members to partially fund the debt service on the loan taken for the remodel. The Capital



Improvement Fee was introduced in 2016 and will continue until the debt is retired. The one-time Initiation Fee will be increased each year in an amount that is at least as much as the previous year's Capital Improvement Fee. This will ensure that new members joining will pay their fair share of the debt service.
