

Welcome to the 2020 swim season! Please carefully read this message because there is much important information to review.

We are targeting an opening date of Saturday, May 16, 2020, depending on weather and staffing availability. We will keep you advised by email as the season approaches. The pool is scheduled to close on Sunday, September 12, 2020 (may also be adjusted as weather and staffing permits).

What's New for 2020?

We have submitted a Request for Proposal for Year Round operations beginning in September 2020. There will be responses from several swim clubs throughout the area. We hosted an open house on March 7, 2020 from 9am - 12pm so that other swim clubs could check out our facilities and have a meet and greet with Jordan. We will be making a decision about our new tenant before the 2020 swim season is over. As this decision is finalized, we will continue to communicate and keep our swim community updated on the new Winter programming and hours of operation.

We have a few new things for you to enjoy this year; completion of lawn chair orders, a new pool cover, new guard chair, LED lights in the pool and some bathroom updates! We will be providing shower mats, towel hooks and stand alone shelving for shampoo and other toiletries.

We are hiring!

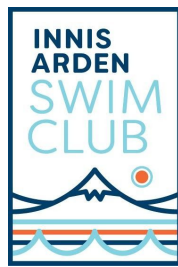

2020 Membership Renewal Information – PLEASE READ!

Membership renewal will be an online process again this year, and we will continue using the Amilia registration software. Within the next few days, we will send an email notification advising that registration is open. This email will include instructions for accessing your Amilia account. From your account, you will easily be able to pay your dues and register kids for teams.

We will be scheduling office hours at the pool should you wish to have personal assistance with membership renewal. The dates and times of these office hours will be provided in the forthcoming renewal instruction email.

All Members who complete their renewal and pay in full by April 30, 2020 will receive 20 free guest passes – a \$100 value!



2020 Dues and Fees

The board is committed to keeping the cost of your membership reasonable and consistent with other similar swim clubs, and we are working hard to identify additional revenue sources. As hourly wages continue to rise, we will be raising Annual Membership Dues for 2020 by ~ 3%. Also, due to the increased use of credit card payments by our members, we will pass along a portion of the cost of credit card processing at the time of renewal check out. Details on this will be included in the forthcoming renewal instruction email. You will have the opportunity to avoid credit card processing fees by paying with a check.

The Capital Improvement Fee for 2020 will remain at \$250 for the fourth consecutive year. This fee is paid by all members to partially fund the debt service on the loan taken for the remodel. The Capital Improvement Fee was introduced in 2016 and will continue until the debt is retired. The one-time Initiation Fee will be increased each year in an amount that is at least as much as the previous year's Capital Improvement Fee. This will ensure that new members joining will pay their fair share of the debt service.

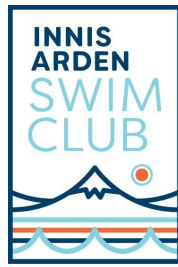
Notice of Annual Membership Meeting
